A Framework for Prayer

2 Thessalonians 1:3-12

3 focuses of Paul's prayer

1. Prayer's Praise – 1:3,4

What was Paul grateful for? (2-fold)

How has your faith grown in last year? How is love increasing?

Prayer Point: *What intentional effort will you make to grow in faith? Increase love in 2018?*

Who are you praying for that this happens in their lives?

Who's names come to mind because of growing faith/increasing love? Thank God for them right now? (Consider doing something for them later on)

2. Prayer's Promise – 1:5-10

God's just judgment (v.6) sets tone for next 5 versus – how is it two-fold?

2 Timothy 3:12

Notice the dramatic/descriptive words used to describe their punishment? V.9

Against whom is his wrath? V. 8

Prayer Point: *Maybe your struggling in your faith, or you know somebody who is? Remember, God is Just!*

Would you stop and say a prayer for them? How might you encourage them?

3. Prayer's Purpose – 1:11,12

What three-fold purposes of prayer does Paul mention here?

Prayer Point: *What are some unfulfilled purposes in your life? Or in others close to you?*

Please pray that God would carry through to completion his purposes
