Looking Back

How had God shown himself in your life this past week?

Pray for God to reveal His truth to you through the Bible.

Looking Up – Read Ephesians 3:14-21

What kind of “riches” is Paul referring to in verse 16, and what kind of “strength” in verse 17?

How have you experienced the “riches” and the “strength” of God?

What does it look like for someone to be “rooted and established” in the love of Christ?

What was it that caused the message of the gospel to “take root” in your life?

Do you ever find yourself doubting the love of God? Why?

Does Paul’s prayer in verses 18-19 offer any encouragement?

Can you think of a time when God surprised you by doing something greater than you could have imagined?

On average, what is the “size” of your prayers?

- I generally pray about things that I could likely accomplish in my own power or “in the flesh”.
- I generally pray about things that would require God’s intervention to be accomplished.

Why are people often hesitant to pray “big” prayers?

Read Ephesians 4:14-21 again. Then read James 1:5-8; James 5:16; 1 John 5:14-15; Hebrews 4:16.
