Proverbs 13:20

Looking Back: For what are you thankful? What has you stressed? Pray. Praise God for who he is, thank God for what he is doing and ask God for his help.

Have you seen God do anything special recently?

How have you been able to put into practice something from what God is teaching you? Have you shared anything you learned with someone?

Reread Proverbs 13:20, 27:17, 17:7, and 27:6 . Use a different translation if possible, and discuss the following questions.

What do these passages teach about God?

What do these passages teach about man?

What do these passages teach about the life God would have us live?

Looking Forward: Pray. Ask God to help you obey his Word.

Make a commitment to obey, train, or share this lesson using “I will . . .” statements.

How will you apply these passages?

Who can you train to start a new group?

With whom will you share this story, or your story?
