What do these passages teach about God?

What do these passages teach about man?

What do these passages teach about the life God would have us live?

Looking Forward: Pray. Ask God to help you obey his Word.

Make a commitment to obey, train, or share this lesson using “I will . . .” statements. How will you obey this passage?
